Enacted in 2000 and in operation in the UK since 2005, the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act has revealed information which has generated calls for constitutional reform. A massive 'information jurisprudence' has developed through the decisions of the Information Commissioner, the Information Tribunal and the courts.

Governments' responses to the war on terror have involved increased resort to claims of national security and accompanying secrecy, but these developments have to exist alongside demands for FOI and transparency. FOI has to balance access to and protection of personal information, and major amendments have been made to the Data Protection Act in order to balance the competing demands of transparency and privacy. This detailed discussion of FOI laws and personal data laws examines the historical development of secrecy, national security and government, and their modern context.

Introducing Globalization

The mainstay of federal business taxation, the US corporate income tax, is riddled with distortions and inequities. As a means of taxing the richest Americans--a popular goal--the corporate income tax is a hopeless failure. Many companies pay no corporate tax, and among those that do, the burden is highly uneven. Meanwhile, the richest Americans command income from numerous sources besides corporate dividends. The distortions and inequities are amazing. Under pressure from business lobbies, Congress legislates deductions and exemptions that twist the corporate tax base far from any plausible financial definition; then Congress enacts "targeted" tax credits to carry out ersatz industrial policies. Faced with a tax terrain of mountains and ravines, corporations employ armies of lawyers and accountants to devise avoidance strategies. This book proposes to replace the

corporate income tax with a tax that has a much broader base at a much lower rate. Two alternatives are explored: the National Retail Sales Tax (NRST) and the Corporate Activity Tax (CAT). To address the issue of regressivity, both alternatives are coupled with measures to preserve the real spending power of households at the lowest income levels.

There is a consensus that the full consequences of the crisis would probably take years to become manifest and just as long for scholars to tease out all the intertwined strands of causality. Two questions about the crisis, however, seemed amenable to immediate analysis: Had the crisis made any difference in the way that short-term movements in various financial markets are linked to each other? And had anything happened to the traditional position of U.S. markets in setting

the pattern for movements in global financial markets? This paper is an early examination of these questions. There are, of course, many financial markets in the world and many possible linkages among them. We chose to begin this analysis with an examination of linkages among major equity markets, in the United States, the UK, and Japan. Similar analyses of other financial linkages are possible, and perhaps the findings of this research will raise additional questions and suggest additional analyses.
