The next two sections cover policy inputs (in areas such as pensions, health care, disability, care of the elderly, unemployment, and labour market activation) and their outcomes (in terms of inequality and poverty, macroeconomic performance, and retrenchment). The seventh section consists of seven chapters which survey

welfare state experience around the globe (and not just within the OECD). Two final chapters consider questions about the global future of the welfare state. The individual chapters of the Handbook are written in an informed but accessible way by leading researchers in their respective fields giving the reader an excellent and truly up-to-date knowledge of the area under discussion. Taken together, they constitute a comprehensive compendium of all that is best in contemporary welfare state research and a unique guide to what is happening now in this most crucial and contested area of social and political development.

La correspondance littéraire de Grimm, continuée par Meister, est la plus célèbre des revues clandestines ; envoyée sous forme d'exemplaires manuscrits de 1753 à 1793, puis jusqu'à 1813, à de rares souverains et princes éclairés de l'Europe, elle fut cependant connue et utilisée par Goethe et Schiller. Elle ne fut imprimée que de façon incomplète, y compris dans l'édition Tourneux (1877-1882), la dernière. Elle n'a fait l'objet jusqu'à présent d'aucune étude systématique. De nos jours elle a inspiré de nouvelles recherches, rendues possibles par la révélation des manuscrits originaux, qui ont posé les problèmes de la rédaction, de la diffusion et de l'influence de cette Correspondance. Tel fut l'objet du colloque organisé en commun à Sarrebruck en février 1974 par Jean Varloot, Directeur de recherche au C.N.R.S., spécialiste de Diderot et des périodiques du XVIII^e siècle et par Jochen Schlobach, Professeur à l'Université de la Sarre, spécialiste de Grimm. Par l'originalité des interventions et par l'intérêt soutenu des débats, ce colloque a renouvelé complètement la question. Ces Actes seront indispensables à tous ceux qui s'intéressent à l'histoire des rapports internationaux au XVIII^e siècle, dans le domaine des idées, de la littérature et des arts ; ils donnent une image nouvelle de l'Europe des Lumières.

This is the first full-scale biography, in any language, of a towering figure in German and European Romanticism: August Wilhelm Schlegel whose life, 1767 to 1845, coincided with its inexorable rise. As poet, translator, critic and oriental scholar, Schlegel's extraordinarily diverse interests and writings left a vast intellectual legacy, making him a foundational figure in several branches of knowledge. He was one of the last thinkers in Europe able to practise as well as to theorise, and to attempt to comprehend the nature of culture without being forced to be a narrow specialist. With his brother Friedrich, for example, Schlegel edited the avant-garde Romantic periodical Athenaeum; and he produced with his wife Caroline a translation of Shakespeare, the first metrical version into any foreign

language. Schlegel's Lectures on Dramatic Art and Literature were a defining force for Coleridge and for the French Romantics. But his interests extended to French, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese literature, as well to the Greek and Latin classics, and to Sanskrit. August Wilhelm Schlegel is the first attempt to engage with this totality, to combine an account of Schlegel's life and times with a critical evaluation of his work and its influence. Through the study of one man's rich life, incorporating the most recent scholarship, theoretical approaches, and archival resources, while remaining easily accessible to all readers, Paulin has recovered the intellectual climate of Romanticism in Germany and traced its development into a still-potent international movement. The extraordinarily wide scope and variety of Schlegel's activities have hitherto acted as a barrier to literary scholars, even in Germany. In Roger Paulin, whose career has given him the knowledge and the experience to grapple with such an ambitious project, Schlegel has at last found a worthy exponent.

Communication in Modern Social Ordering investigates the modern history of communication in relation to the thinking of the political community in the United States. By illustrating the intertwining of the technological developments in communication methods and its community-building effects, the different representations of society and their political implications are examined against the development of communication systems from the telegraph, to the telephone, to computer networks. It was the telegraph that made communication a continual process, thus freeing it from the rhythmical motion of the postal service and from physical transportation in general, and provided both a model and a mechanism of control. Using the theories of both Foucault and Heidegger to provide a lens for new investigation, the author studies not the meanings of communication and its logic as such but rather the conditions and structures that allow meanings and logic to be formulated in the first place. The book offers an original combination of historical analysis with an ontological discussion of the evolution of telecommunications in the U.S. as a phenomenon of modern social ordering.
