Facilitating Interdisciplinary Research examines current interdisciplinary research efforts and recommends ways to stimulate and support such research. Advances in science and engineering increasingly require the collaboration of scholars from various fields. This shift is driven by the need to address complex problems that cut across traditional disciplines, and the capacity of new technologies to both transform existing disciplines and generate new ones. At the same time, however, interdisciplinary research can be impeded by policies on hiring, promotion, tenure, proposal review, and resource allocation that favor traditional disciplines. This report identifies steps that researchers, teachers, students, institutions, funding organizations, and disciplinary societies can take to more effectively conduct, facilitate, and evaluate interdisciplinary research programs and projects. Among major contributions included are essays on gold funerary offerings from excavations at Bat n Grande, Peru; the description of recently discovered Malagana goldwork from Colombia; and recent finds of gold in archaeological contexts from Panama. This is the first interdisciplinary volume of its kind to cover a wide range of the principal Precolumbian goldworking cultures in the Americas. Both authoritative and accessible, it will be an important reference work for scholars but equally of interest to the non-specialist.

This book presents a comprehensive guide of the required entry documentation needed to clear commercial shipments into the United States. It starts with the importer's responsibilities under the Customs Modernization Act and presents examples of how an importer can take reasonable care, thus avoiding delays in release of cargo and any penalties for non-compliance. A chapter on terms of sale is included which explains the 13 incoterms which were published by the International Chamber of Commerce and how they affect the importer's and exporter's risk and responsibilities for transporting the goods from overseas to the United States. The complete entry process with a copy of the Customs entry (release) document and the Customs entry summary (payment of duties) is illustrated with detailed information. Other forms of entry such as in-bonds, informals, appraisement, warehouse, temporary importations, and drawback critics are covered in this book. There is also a section on the operation of foreign trade zones in the United States. Classification of goods using the Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS) of the United States is required before an importer can make entry in order to determine the proper duty rate, possible quotas/visas for textiles, and other agency requirements. An explanation and examples of each of the six general rules of interpretation (GRIs) are presented in this book. These rules must be followed by countries all over the world which are members of the Harmonized System Convention. In addition, there is a summary of the 24 general notes to the HTS, many of which cover trade agreements that offer preferential or free rates of duty to importers. All merchandise imported into the United States is subject to the appraisement under the Trade Agreements Act of 1979. The six different methods of appraisement are covered with examples and information that may be required on your invoice before entry can be made into the United States. Every article of foreign origin entering the United States must be legibly marked with the English name of the country of origin unless an exception from marking is provided for in the law. This section covers marking requirements and the exceptions to marking on your products and their containers. Some products require approval from other federal or state agencies before they can be released by U.S. Customs, Prohibitions, restrictions, and other agency requirements are covered in this book. New record keeping penalties were instituted under the Customs Modernization Act for failure to maintain the proper records for a specific period of time and produce them on time upon Customs request. The required entry records referred to as the "(A)(1) List." Flow charts for the administrative process that takes place for fines, penalties, or liquidated damages are covered in detail and requirements for prior disclosure. An annex providing copies of the most frequently used Customs forms are included at the end of this book.
