Alors que le " mythe hasbsbourgeois " nous avait entraînés à relire l'histoire de la monarchie danubienne finissante comme celle du dernier âge d'or de l'Europe centrale et de la cohabitation harmonieuse des peuples et des nationalités, l'Autriche prenait la tête du mouvement qui voudrait conduire aujourd'hui toute la Mitteleuropa sur la voie du néo-nationalisme, défini en termes ethnico-régionalistes, indifférent aux valeurs démocratiques, anti-européen sous couleur d'anti- "mondialisme". J'avais vingt ans lorsque je suis arrivé à Vienne en septembre 1974 pour une année universitaire. Depuis ce début d'année 2000, je gère une rupture sentimentale.

This book represents the first multidisciplinary scientific work on a deep volcanic maar lake in comparison with other similar temperate lakes. The syntheses of the main characteristics of Lake Pavin are, for the first time, set in a firmer footing comparative approach, encompassing regional, national, European and international aquatic science contexts. It is a unique lake because of its permanently anoxic monimolimnion, and furthermore, because of its small surface area, its substantially low human influence, and by the fact that it does not have a river inflow.
